It's common to see the preposition "of" used alongside helper verbs like "should" or "must.". For example: I should of gone to bed earlier. . However, this is an error. The correct word here isn't even a preposition. Rather, it should be the verb "have," which sounds a bit like "of" when spoken (hence the confusion).

In addition, Yu and Yoo (2010) analyzed errors with prepositional verbs (e.g., believe in, ask for) in 416 Korean university students' argumentative essays, classifying the errors into five categories--omission, wrong preposition, addition, misordering, and others--and found that omission errors accounted for 54% of the total prepositional verb errors, followed by addition errors (12%) and the wrong preposition (18%).
