Boaters can help by inspecting ramp conditions before launching their watercraft to ensure there are no hazardous conditions present. If a boat ramp is not yet ready for use, boaters can locate alternate access sites by visiting [mndnr.gov/wateraccess](http://mndnr.gov/wateraccess). New DWI law went into effect Aug. 1, 2019. A watercraft license is not required for: Non-motorized watercraft 10 ft or less, or a watercraft owned by a person from another state and that state does not require licensing of that type of watercraft and it is not within Minnesota for more than 90 consecutive days. Minnesota Boating Laws and Regulations Age and Operator Restrictions Children less than 13 years old may not operate a PWC, even with an adult on board. PWC operators 13 years of age must have either someone at least 21 years old on board, or a Watercraft Operator's Permit and be under visual supervision by someone at least 21 years old.
