The orientation program for new RNs in the NICU is 12 to 18 weeks. We hire experienced nurses as well as new graduate nurses. Two of those weeks of orientation are dedicated to class time while the rest is spent working closely with a preceptor. Orientation education covers everything from hands-on skills to developmental care of the neonate.

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
